Please keep our sister Columbiette, Tracy Patterson, in your prayers. She was recently in the hospital for surgery and is now recovering at home.

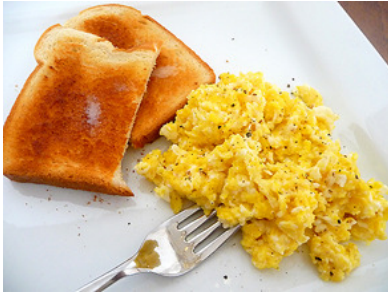
